FIRSTMARK CREDIT UNION has a proud legacy deeply rooted in education. In 1932, during the Great Depression, ten teachers began the credit union to serve their peers in the school districts. San Antonio Teachers Credit Union (SATCU), the first state-chartered credit union in San Antonio, operated from our original location at what is known today as Fox Tech High School in the San Antonio Independent School District. Firstmark has grown their original \$475 investment to over \$1 billion in assets.

As a financial cooperative owned by our members, there is a collective power supporting our credit union movement — people helping people — and together, your membership makes the difference as we continue to chart a course that celebrates our roots in education, gives back to the communities we serve, and provides solutions to help meet the financial goals of all members, school employees, and their families.




POWER OF THE DOLLAR®

The Firstmark Foundation continued to make exceptional strides in building a positive presence throughout San Antonio and the surrounding area by providing education grants, student scholarships, high impact grants, and essential funding for important initiatives that help create sustainability within the education system. As an extension of the credit union founded by teachers on the philosophy of people helping people, the Foundation remains mission-focused and committed more than ever to giving back to our schools.

In 2024, the Foundation, alongside Power of the Dollar® members, gave \$100,000 to SAMSAT™ in support of their program to assist teachers who serve the underserved. The Foundation also gave 20 educators \$1,000 each in grant funds, which in turn were utilized to help provide for their students. In addition, they awarded \$20,000 in student scholarships, handed out 1,000 turkeys at their fourth annual Turkeys for Teachers, and donated nearly \$2,000 to schools during their classroom supply drive.
